Confederate Fort Collier was at the center of the Third Battle of Winchester where late in the afternoon of September 19, 1864, the thunderous Union cavalry charge, led by George Armstrong Custer, turned the tide of the battle for the Federals. Today, the site is preserved and known as the Fort Collier Civil War Center.

9:00am to 5:00pm: 5th Annual "Cavalry Returns to Fort Collier" -- A day-long event with a kids' camp from 9 to Noon, living history and tours.
