Confederate Fort Collier was at the center the Third Battle of Winchester, where late in the afternoon of September 19th, 1864 the thunderous Union cavalry charge, led by George Armstrong Custer, turned the tide of the battle for the Federals. Today the site is preserved as The Fort Collier Civil War Center, a non-profit preservation organization.
